  - Registration opens Sept. 4th
    - \$3 for one semester
    - \$5 for both semesters
  - Forecasting begins on Sept. 25<sup>th</sup>
  - Commitment Contract
    - \$5 deposit that you can earn back
    - Lose a dollar each time you miss a forecast
    - Don't miss forecasts if you want your money back
  - Please remember that not forecasting will bring the entire team down, so give it some thought before you sign up
  - Scott will need the following from you by Sept. 18th:
    - 6-character username
    - 9-character password
    - Registration and deposit fees
    - Grade classification
- Iowa State Daily Forecasting
  - Teams will forecast for the University newspaper (3-4 days a week for Ames)
  - Team captains will submit the forecasts to both Scott and the ISD editor
  - Fun way to compete and gain casual forecasting experience!
  - Will start Sept. 10th
- Forecasting tutorial will be held in the first week of September!
- \*NEW\* Monthly Climate Prediction Game
  - Forecast the average high temp, average low temp, total precip, and total snowfall for various locations!
  - Starts Sept. 1st

- Turn in forecasts by midnight of the start of the month
  - For example, August 31<sup>st</sup> 11:59pm
- Different kind of forecasting, and a great way to broaden your skillset and perspectives
